## Sunday, June 4 Depart from USA

Your Land and Leadership of John Wesley© travel study program begins as you depart the United States on your international flight to England.

# Monday, June 5 - Salisbury Arrival at Sarum College

Arrive in London this morning where our representative will greet you outside the baggage claim area. Enjoy the English countryside as you travel to Salisbury. After lunch and a welcome at Sarum College by Dr. Whitesel, you'll tour nearby Salisbury Cathedral, home to the best preserved Magna Carta. With Britain's tallest spire, the church is a beautiful example of Early English architecture. Unlike most cathedrals built over several centuries with varying styles, Salisbury's main cathedral was completed in only 38 years. Return to Sarum College for tea, a reception and orientation with Dr. Whitesel. Overnight at Sarum College.

## Tuesday, June 6 Swanwick, Derbyshire

Travel to Warrick Castle in Swanwick. The medieval world comes to life as you explore battlements, towers, and the Great Hall. Untangle the political intrigues of over a thousand years of history, including how one earl toppled kings. Savor the fragrance of the Victorian rose garden and the beauty of the peacock garden with its strutting peacocks. Exhibitions featuring archery and birds of prey are offered, as well as a demonstration of the world's largest working siege machine as it catapults a fireball. Following supper at Hayes

Conference Centre, Dr. Whitesel will give an overview of English history's influence on Wesley. Overnight at the Hayes Conference Centre.

## Wednesday, June 7 - Epworth

Today's destination is Epworth, where Samuel and Susanna Wesley raised their brood of children in the Old Rectory while he served the Parish Church for 39 years. As you tour this childhood home of the Wesleys, Dr. Whitesel will share fascinating stories to familiarize you with their upbringing and early life. Enjoy lunch at St. Andrews Church before touring the church and sharing Communion. Dr. Whitesel will lead a recreation of the famous sermon Wesley gave from atop his father's tombstone. Depart St. Andrews and return to Sarum College, stopping en route for supper (meal is on your own).

## Thursday, June 8 - Oxford

Travel to the university town of Oxford, and tour Christ Church. After lunch, enjoy a re-creation of a "Holy Club" meeting led by Dr. Whitesel in Lincoln College's Chapel before touring the Wesley Room, preserved to look like the room he used while a professor here. In St. Mary's Church, you'll experience a re-creation of the sermon "Salvation by Faith" that Wesley once preached here. Enjoy dinner on your own with friends before leaving Oxford to return to Sarum College for your overnight.

## Friday, June 9 - London

Leave Sarum College for London and visit the Fetter Lane Society. Using Wesley's own words, Dr. Whitesel will explain

# the footsteps of Wesley



how Wesley's faith grew through the experiences he shared with the Moravians at their Fetter Lane meetings. Explore the City of London around St. Paul's Cathedral and see the famous Millennial Bridge that crosses the Thames. In the afternoon visit the magnificent St. Paul's Cathedral, then experience their "Evensong" worship just as Wesley did. After dinner on your own, meet on Aldersgate Street where Dr. Whitesel will lead a special re-creation of the night Wesley's heart was warmed and Wesley became a changed man. Check into the Royal Foundation of St. Catherine for your overnight.

### Saturday, June 10 London

This morning, tour the Tower of London. Although this historic castle was not originally intended to be a prison, it once held kings, queens and even religious leaders. See the Crown Jewels as well as the Yeoman Wardens, and enjoy historical reenactments. Then board your coach to visit Wesley's House and museum. You can even briefly stop to pray in Wesley's prayer closet. Then in the Wesley Memorial Chapel sit on the same benches on which Wesleyans sat to listen to Wesley where you will hear historical insights by Dr. Whitesel on his research into original Wesley writings. Return to overnight in Salisbury at Sarum College.

## Sunday, June 11 Salisbury

Today is free for you to spend as you like in the medieval city of Salisbury.


